## POE INFORMATION

This program is open to young people **ages 13-18** who have keyboard proficiency at the early intermediate level. Prior organ study is not a requirement. **Arrive for check-in at Texas Christian University 3-4 pm, Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup>. POE ends at noon, Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup>.**

**POE MAIN CAMPUS:** Texas Christian University in Fort Worth.

**REGISTRATION FEE** includes all housing, meals (Sunday dinner through Friday breakfast) local transportation, class materials/music scores, POE T-shirt, and a one-year Student Membership in the American Guild of Organists and subscription to *The American Organist*. The fee **DOES NOT INCLUDE** arrival/departure travel. Students traveling by air, bus or rail will be transported free from and to their terminals by POE staff.

**EARLY REGISTRATION FEE** of \$350 is available for applications received on or before **May 1, 2010**. After that date, the regular fee of \$395 will apply. **No registrations will be accepted after July 1, 2010.**

*Cancellation fee of \$25 applies to a refund request prior to July 1; no refunds given after that date.*

**REGISTRATION IS LIMITED TO THE FIRST 24 STUDENTS WHO APPLY, SO BE SURE TO APPLY EARLY!**

**HOUSING** will be provided on the campus of Texas Christian University in air-conditioned, double occupancy dormitory rooms. Most meals will be served at the university.

*Students will be under full-time supervision by the POE staff.*
